Extract from the journal of Commander J. C. Beaumont, U. S. Navy.

U. S. S. MACKINAW,

James River, June 17, 1862.

Calm and pleasant; air 72° to 88°. At about 4:30 p. m. steamer *Winans* came down the river and reported having been fired into from near Wilcox's Wharf. At 4:35 the rebels opened upon us. Got underway and steamed up to Wilcox's and soon dispersed them. Pontoon bridge taken up.
